Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Fairfield Nursing and Rehabilitation Center's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what our facility is doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

We are happy to report we have not had any additional confirmed cases of COVID-19 since May 15th, with a total of 34 residents and 27 staff members that tested positive for COVID-19. Of those positive cases, 28 residents and 23 staff members have resolved.

We are committed to eliminating this virus from our facility, and as we previously reported, we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community.

As a reminder, we will continue to post updates on our facility website and we will individually notify representatives/families regarding a resident's condition if he/she tests positive for COVID-19 or is displaying symptoms of COVID-19.
