Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

As we approach summer and states are starting to reopen slowly, we want you to know that the staff at Fairfield Nursing and Rehabilitation Center continues to work hard to prevent further spread of COVID-19 in our facility.

Since our last update, there have not been any additional confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. Of the 34 residents and 27 staff members that tested positive, 33 residents and 24 staff members have resolved.

In addition to the increased safety precautions we have previously reported, our facility also has a dedicated COVID unit for our COVID positive residents. There are dedicated staff members working on the COVID unit that do not provide care in any other part of the facility to reduce the risk of transmission of the virus. We are committed to continue seeing the number of positive cases in our facility decrease and we will work with our federal, state and local health officials to protect our residents and staff to stop further spread of this virus in our facility.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
